Classes

The GED test measures the academic skills and concepts of a traditional high school education. When the student successfully completes the GED, the state of California issues an equivalency certificate which meets the high school diploma requirement for most employers, vocational schools and colleges.

GED Classes prepare students to successfully pass the examination in these subjects:

- Reading
- Writing
- Social Studies
- Science
- Math

- Students must attend an orientation before beginning classes. During the orientation you will be assessed for reading and math to place you in the proper class.
- To register for the orientation, visit the welcome center or call (831) 796-6908 or (831) 796-6905.
- The school year is divided into 6-week cycles.
- The fee for the class is \$10 for each 6-week cycle.
- GED classes and tests are offered in both English and Spanish at the Salinas Adult School.

You must be 18 years old or older to attend the Salinas Adult School.
